

ANALYSIS OF PUBLIC ATTITUDE TO NUCLEAR POWER

Psychological features of nuclear power public perception, reasons of anti-nuclear movement and social components of its participants are considered. The results of some public opinion polls on nuclear power are analyzed, and factors, which influence on opinion, are discussed.
